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



Office Trailers for Clayville Unit 1 Construction Project

The Vineland Municipal Electric Utility will be constructing a simple cycle combustion turbine power plant adjacent to the existing Clayville Substation. Construction is scheduled to begin in January 2014. This request for proposals is for the lease of office trailers to be located at the Clayville Unit 1 construction site. A first trailer (the VMEU trailer) will be occupied by VMEU personnel beginning in late February 2014. The VMEU trailer will be leased for a minimum term of 15 months, with automatic extensions on a month-by-month basis.

The proposed lease agreement also includes two options for the lease of two additional trailers. If the first option is exercised, then one of the additional trailers (the Rolls-Royce trailer) will be occupied by employees of the combustion turbine manufacturer (Rolls-Royce), and will be leased for a minimum term of 12 months with automatic extensions on a month-by-month basis. If the second option is exercised, the second additional trailer (the commissioning trailer) will be occupied by employees of the commissioning agent (TBD), and will be leased for a minimum term of 4 months with automatic extensions.
