## RESOLUTION NO. 2014-111

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE MAYOR, MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK AND STAFF, CITY SOLICITOR AND STAFF, BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR AND STAFF, THE CITY COMPTROLLER AND LABOR COUNSEL AND STAFF CONCERNING ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, OR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WHICH ARE PROPOSED FOR INCLUSION IN ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, INCLUDING THE NEGOTIATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF WITH EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE PUBLIC BODY AND AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING AS PROVIDED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the Mayor, Members of City Council, City Clerk and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, Business Administrator and Staff, the City Comptroller and Labor Counsel and Staff, concerning any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that:

1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland on Tuesday, March 11, 2014, at the Caucus Room, 640 Wood Street, Vineland, New Jersey, immediately following adjournment of the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland.

2. The general nature of the subject matters of the closed meeting shall pertain to any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Mayor, Members of City Council, City Clerk and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, Business Administrator and Staff, the City Comptroller and Labor Counsel and Staff shall be made following a final decision and determination of said matter.

4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
