## RESOLUTION NO. 2014 -171

RESOLUTION EXCLUDING THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS, CITY CLERK AND STAFF, CITY SOLICITOR, BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR AND STAFF, CITY COMPTROLLER, CITY AUDITOR AND LABOR COUNSEL CONCERNING ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, OR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WHICH ARE PROPOSED FOR INCLUSION IN ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, INCLUDING THE NEGOTIATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF WITH EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE PUBLIC BODY AND AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE OF SAID MEETING MINUTES.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the Mayor, City Council Members, City Clerk and Staff, City Solicitor, Business Administrator and Staff, City Comptroller, City Auditor and Labor Counsel concerning collective bargaining negotiations with the Vineland Superior Officers Association (VSOA).

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that:

- 1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the aforesaid individuals on Tuesday, May 6, 2014, at 640 Wood Street, immediately following adjournment of the work session of the Council of the City of Vineland.
- 2. The general nature of the subject matter of the closed meeting shall pertain to VSOA negotiations.
- 3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Mayor, City Council Members, City Clerk and Staff, City Solicitor, Business Administrator and Staff, City Comptroller, City Auditor and Labor Counsel shall be made following the final decision and determination of said matter which is estimated to be 90 days.
- 4. The Clerk at the present public meeting shall read the title of said Resolution aloud so that members of the public in attendance can understand as precisely as possible the nature of the matter that will privately be discussed.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
- 6. The Clerk on the next business day following this meeting shall furnish a copy of the Resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq.
