NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that the action of the Mayor of the City of Vineland in appointing Edwin F. Alicea, Sr. as Director of the Police Department designed as Director of Public Safety, to be paid in the same manner as other directors and officers of the City of Vineland, is hereby ratified and confirmed, said appointment effective as of June 11, 2014.
