

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-339

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF  
SUB-GRANTEE AGREEMENTS FOR THE USE OF FISCAL  
YEAR 2014 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK  
GRANT FUNDS FOR PUBLIC SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has entered into a Grant Agreement with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Fiscal Year 2014 Community Development Block Grant Program funding, and

WHEREAS, said contract with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development provides for the subgranting by the City of Vineland of a portion of the F. Y. 2014 Community Development Block Grant funding to subrecipient non-profit organizations to be utilized for public services as set forth in the Final Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds for Federal Fiscal Year 2014, filed with HUD by the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that the Mayor and City Clerk be and the same are hereby authorized to execute Contract Agreements between the City of Vineland and the following organizations which are subrecipients of grant funding as approved under the City's Fiscal Year 2014 Community Development Block Grant Program:
