## RESOLUTION NO. 2014-453

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK AND STAFF, BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION STAFF, CITY SOLICITOR AND STAFF, THE CITY COMPTROLLER AND STAFF, CONCERNING EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENTS, INCLUDING THE NEGOTIATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF WITH EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE PUBLIC BODY AND AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING AS PROVIDED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves terms and conditions of an existing or proposed contract negotiations for the Chief of EMS and the Chief of Fire, including negotiation positions, in which the public body is or may become a party; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the Mayor, City Clerk, Business Administration staff, City Solicitor and staff, City Comptroller and staff concerning Employment Agreements with the Chief of EMS and the Chief of Fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that:

- The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland on November 10, 2014, in the Caucus Room, City Hall, Vineland, New Jersey, immediately following adjournment of the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland.
- 2. The general nature of the subject matters of the closed meeting shall pertain to Employment Agreements with the Chief of EMS and the Chief of Fire.
- 3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Council of the City of Vineland, the Mayor, City Clerk and staff, Business Administration staff, City Solicitor and staff, City Comptroller and staff shall be made following a final decision and determination of said matter excepting information which must remain private.
- 4. It is anticipated that the minutes of the deliberation conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public within sixty (60) days, however, any personal confidential information may not be released.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
