WHEREAS, the City of Vineland desires to enter into an agreement with Woodruff Energy US, LLC for Supply and Delivery of Natural Gas for City Buildings under the SJPC contract awarded by the County of Camden, for a term of 24-months commencing with the first (1<sup>st</sup>) meter reading after November 30, 2014, at a cost of \$0.6128 per dekatherm upon mutual agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the City Comptroller has certified the availability of funds for the contract to be awarded herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND, as follows:

- 1. THAT the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Woodruff Energy US, LLC for Supply and Delivery of Natural Gas, for a term of 24-months commencing with the first (1<sup>st</sup>) meter reading after November 30, 2014, at a cost of \$0.6128 per dekatherm as conditioned in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 and upon mutual agreement of the parties based upon the open-end contract awarded by the County of Camden under South Jersey Power Cooperative.
- 2. THAT the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue a purchase order contract to Woodruff Energy US, LLC for Supply and Delivery of Natural Gas for City Buildings, as stated above.
