

RESOLUTION NO. 2015- 232

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT MODIFICATION NO. 1 WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION WITH RESPECT TO THE RESURFACING OF LANDIS AVENUE, PHASE I FROM MYRTLE STREET TO BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland on February 24, 2015, adopted Resolution 2015-88 authorizing the execution of a cost reimbursement agreement with the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) with respect to the Resurfacing of Landis Avenue, Phase I from Myrtle Street to Boulevard under Federal Project No. STP-1030 (108) Construction; and

WHEREAS, the City had requested additional funding to provide for construction engineering, for which the State has submitted Modification Agreement No. 1 for the amount of \$57,469.00 increasing the reimbursement amount from \$1,933,471.00 to \$1,990,940.00; and

WHEREAS, the City must submit along with final reimbursement documents, a certified copy of this resolution and four (4) original fully executed agreements for each modification; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that the Mayor of the City of Vineland is hereby authorized to execute the Modification Agreement No. 1 between the New Jersey Department of Transportation and the City of Vineland with respect to the Resurfacing of Landis Avenue, Phase I from Myrtle Street to Boulevard under Federal Project No. STP-1030 (108) Construction.

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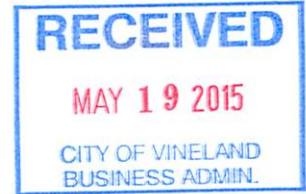


