## SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR GARDEN & MILL TRAFFIC SIGNAL

This contract is to be federally funded by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). As such, there are some very specific things to be done in managing this Request for Proposals:

- The Request is to be advertised three weeks in a local newspaper as well as a regional newspaper.
- The RFP and corresponding contract may not have any "Pay to Play" requirements in it. This is passed down from the feds.
- When the Proposals are received, DO NOT OPEN THE COST PROPOSALS.
  Proposers are to submit separately sealed technical and cost proposals.
  The federal process requires a review based solely on technical merit first, then the cost proposal of ONLY the highest ranked proposer is opened and cost negotiations commence.
