WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for bids for the furnishing and installation of Ambulance Litter Fastener Devices for the Department of Health – Emergency Medical Service Division, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2015, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Assistant Business Administrator for tabulation, evaluation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Business Administrator has, under date of October 6, 2015 submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that a contract for the furnishing and installation of Ambulance Litter Fastener Devices for the Department of Health – EMS Division, be awarded to Bay Head Investments, Inc., Berlin, NJ, in the amount of \$51,570.00, said bid being the only bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that said contract for the furnishing and installation of Ambulance Litter Fastener Devices for the Department of Health – EMS Division, be and the same is awarded to Bay Head Investments, Inc., Berlin, NJ, on their bid in the amount of \$51,570.00, said bid being the only bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland, and the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue purchase order contract for the same in behalf of the City; and

Submitted to you herewith for your consideration is our evaluation of the proposals submitted to the Purchasing Board on August 11, September 9, and September 22, 2015.

FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF COLD WATER METERS – 5/8” THRU 6” FOR THE WATER UTILITY, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF AWARD, WITH OPTION FOR A SECOND YEAR

It is the recommendation of the Director of Municipal Utilities, which has the concurrence of the Purchasing Agent and the Assistant Business Administrator that an open-end contract be awarded to the lowest responsive bidder, Rio Supply Inc., Sicklerville, NJ, in the amount of \$121,503.00. The lower bidder, HD Supply Waterworks LTD, Berlin, NJ bid meters that did not meet specifications. The meters specified are proprietary.

FURNISHING AND INSTALLATION OF AMBULANCE LITTER FASTENER DEVICES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH – EMS DIVISION



We trust that the above recommendation will receive your favorable consideration and that the recommended resolutions will be adopted as presented.

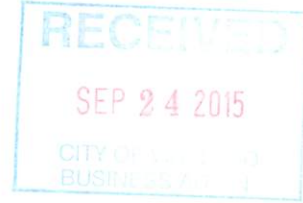



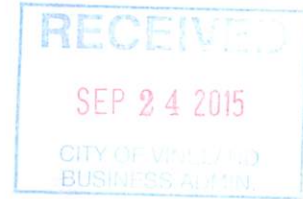

<b>Ambulance Litter Fastener Device Safety Upgrade</b>								
<b>The City of Vineland Emergency Medical Service Division seeks to meet the new safety standard established for ambulance litter integrity, retention and patient restraint.</b>								
<b>On July 1,2015, the US General Services Administration gave notice of change to the Federal Specification for the Star-of-Life Ambulance Standard, KKK-A-1822F. The GSA new standard requires compliance with the Society of Automotive Engineers Standard J3027 and others.</b>								
<b>Also on July 1, 2015, the NJ Department of Health, Office of EMS notified the providers that it regulates, like the City of Vineland, that in the future, it will be enforcing the above standard for newly ordered ambulances. The office recognized, "The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH), the Ambulance Manufacturer's Division (AMD) of the National Truck Equipment Association (NTEA), the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) the Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE), and other entities have collaborated research and subject matter expertise to develop changes in ambulance design standards. The goal is to create improvement in patient compartment safety."</b>								
<b>The City desires to improve the safety of our precious patients sooner rather than later as well as using fiscal prudence in extending the life of new ambulance cots. We therefor need to update our fleet to carry the crash tested, SAE J3027 compliant litter retention system.</b>								
<b>This project will update our two, soon to be delivered ambulances as well as our existing fleet using the funds of bond ordinances 2012-28 and 2014-21.</b>
