

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - ____

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A 2001 FORD F-250 TRUCK NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, TO THE BOROUGH OF NEWFIELD.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36, entitled "Sale or Other Disposition of Personal Property", provides that any contracting unit by resolution of its governing body may authorize the sale of its personal property not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, said statute further provides that the contracting unit need not advertise for bids when it makes any such sale to another contracting unit or any governmental unit in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Newfield has requested acquisition of one (1) 2001 Ford F-250 Truck from the City of Vineland Water Utility;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that:

1. The City-owned 2001 Ford F-250 Water Utility Truck #16, VIN #1FTNF20L01ED78382, determined no longer needed for public use by the City.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Vineland are authorized and directed to execute an Agreement of Sale for the above-cited sale of the 2001 Ford F-250 Truck to the Borough of Newfield for the consideration of \$1.00.
3. The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and directed to execute the bill of sale of said vehicle and release same to the Borough of Newfield.

AGREEMENT OF SALE
BY AND BETWEEN
THE CITY OF VINELAND
AND
THE BOROUGH OF NEWFIELD

THIS AGREEMENT, dated _____, by and between the City of Vineland, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, and the Borough of Newfield.

WHEREAS, the City possesses a 2001 Ford F-250 Water Utility Truck #16, VIN #1FTNF20L01ED78382 that is no longer needed for public use, and the Borough of Newfield has expressed interest in said vehicle; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.. 40A:11-36, entitled "Sale or Other Disposition of Personal Property", provides that any contracting unit by resolution of its governing body may authorize the sale of its personal property not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland has by Resolution authorized the sale of said vehicle from the City of Vineland to the Borough of Newfield.

WHEREAS, the transfer of said vehicle is considered in the best interest of both public entities to further the usefulness of public property.

NOW THEREFORE, be it mutually agreed and understood between the parties that:

1. The 2001 Ford F-250 truck, as indicated above, is no longer needed for public use by the City Water Utility.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Vineland are authorized and directed to execute an Agreement of Sale for the above-cited sale of the F 250 Truck to the Borough of Newfield, for the sum of one-dollar (\$1.00). Said vehicle is being sold "as is" with no warranties express or implied and is acceptable by the Borough of Newfield in its present condition.
3. The City of Vineland Purchasing Agent, upon execution of this Agreement, shall execute the bill of sale, thereby releasing said vehicle to the Borough of Newfield.
4. The Borough of Newfield shall remove the vehicle from City premises at no cost to the City, and remove any City decal or insignia from said vehicle prior to the vehicle being registered by the Borough of Newfield.
5. The Borough of Newfield shall take all responsibility for said vehicle, acquire sufficient motor vehicle insurance and register and inspect said vehicle in compliance with New Jersey Law.
6. This Agreement shall be made without any additional conditions over and above those stipulated herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City of Vineland and the Borough of Newfield have caused these presents to be signed by their respective authorized officials, with the corporate seal of each respective party affixed hereto, the day and year first above written.

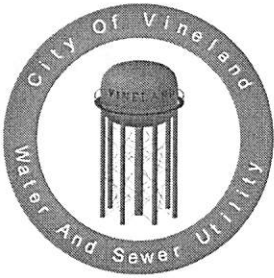

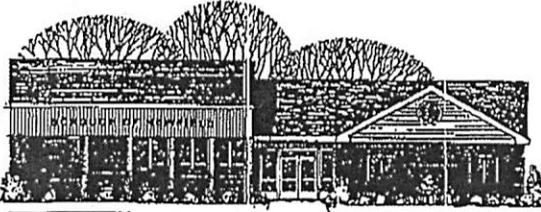
