Reference Sheet Item #	Explanation	
1	Electric Utility	Transfer between Operating Expenses and Bond Interest. To reclass interest payments charged to the Clayville ordinance and moved to the electric operating budget. According to NJ Bond Law we have the option to charge interest to the Improvement Authorization up to six months after completion.
2	Prosecutors Office	Transfer from Gas Oil and Lubricants. Prosecutors Professional services budget did not support the substitute Prosecutor for absences. Additional budget needed for office supply due to increased activity.
3	Municipal Court	Transfer from Salaries to Operating Expense. Recent retirements resulted in only having one Certified Court Administrator on staff for after hours. Used operating expense professional services in lieu of salaries for substitute Certified Court Administrator with a cooperative effort with the Woodbury court.
