RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE MAYOR, MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK AND STAFF, CITY SOLICITOR AND STAFF, ASSISTANT BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR AND STAFF, CITY COMPTROLLER/ FINANCE OFFICER AND STAFF AND LABOR COUNSEL AND STAFF CONCERNING ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, OR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WHICH ARE PROPOSED FOR INCLUSION IN ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, INCLUDING THE NEGOTIATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF WITH EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES THE PUBLIC BODY AND EMPLOYEES OF AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING AS PROVIDED HEREIN

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves any collective bargaining agreement or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement including the negotiations of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the Mayor, Members of City Council, City Clerk and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, Assistant Business Administrator and Staff, the City Comptroller/Finance Officer and staff and Labor Counsel and Staff concerning negotiations with IBEW, Unit-2, IAEP R2-75 and Chief Agreements, the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining or employment agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

- 1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Vineland on Tuesday, January 12, 2016 at 640 Wood Street, immediately upon the conclusion of the regular City Council public meeting.
- 2. The general nature of the subject matter of the closed meeting shall pertain to negotiations with IBEW, Unit-2, IAEP R2-75 and Chief Agreements.
- 3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Mayor, Members of City Council, City Clerk and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, Assistant Business Administrator and Staff, the City Comptroller/Finance Officer and staff and Labor Counsel and Staff shall be made following the final decision and determination of said matter which is estimated to be 90 days.
- 4. The Clerk at the present public meeting shall read the title of said Resolution aloud so that members of the public in attendance can understand as precisely as possible the nature of the matter that will privately be discussed.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
- 6. The Clerk on the next business day following this meeting shall furnish a copy of the Resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq.
