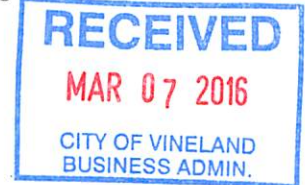

1. **DESCRIPTION OF WORK**

- A. IN GENERAL, the work of this contract consists of providing all labor, equipment and material required to remove the existing WRT Z-88™ Radium Removal Media in the existing four (4) radium removal treatment vessels, dewater and temporarily store the removed media, and test, transport and permanently dispose the removed media; provide and install new Z-88™ Radium Removal Media, as manufactured by Water Remediation Technology, LLC, or approved equal, in the existing four (4) treatment units, test and place the treatment facilities back into permanent service, as further described in these Specifications.
- B. The work also includes providing all mobilizing, demobilizing, permitting including transport manifest and disposal and project site clean-up.

2. **CONTRACT**

- A. The work of this project will be accomplished under a single contract or two (2) contracts (one for removal and disposal of media and one for installation of new media) as designated in the Proposal Form.
