ORDINANCE NO. 2016- 15

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND, CHAPTER 216, ARTICLE I, SECTION I ENTITLED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ANNUAL LICENSE FEES

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to calculate the cost associated with the issuance of renewals of alcoholic beverage license as authorized by NJAC 13:2-4.3 and 4.4 recognizing the time and effort put forth by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the taxpayers to increase the fees as permitted by the aforementioned Administrative Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that City Code, chapter 216 entitled Alcoholic Beverages, Article I Section I entitled Annual License Fee shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

“Annual License Fees shall be as follows (3% increase annually, rounded to the nearest whole dollar, until the maximum amount permitted by New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage control regulations is reached):

- A. Plenary retail consumption (for year 2016): \$1,157.00
(for year 2017): \$1,192.00
(for year 2018): \$1,228.00
(for year 2019): \$1,265.00
(for year 2020): \$1,303.00

- B. Plenary retail distribution (for year 2016): \$561.00
(for year 2017): \$578.00
(for year 2018): \$595.00
(for year 2019): \$613.00
(for year 2020): \$631.00

- C. Club (maximum amount permitted by Alcoholic Beverage Control Regulations)
\$188.00

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any portion of this Ordinance be deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that portion so determined to be unenforceable, shall be void and the balance hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.
