3. The City Clerk of the City of Vineland is hereby authorized and directed to readvertise for bids to be received by the Purchasing Board on October 12, 2016, at which time such bids submitted shall be publicly opened and read aloud.

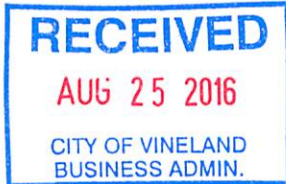
We trust that the above recommendation will receive your favorable consideration and that the recommended resolution will be adopted as presented.

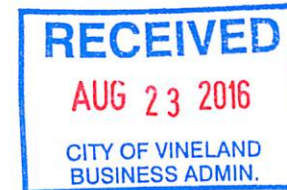
