BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that:

1. The bids received by the Purchasing Board of the City of Vineland on December 28, 2016, for the Landis Avenue Traffic Signal Upgrades, Phase I, are and the same are hereby rejected.
2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately return to said bidders any bid bonds, certified checks, or other forms of security submitted by such bidders.
3. The City Clerk of the City of Vineland is hereby authorized and directed to readvertise for bids to be received by the Purchasing Board on February 28, 2017, at which time such bids submitted shall be publicly opened and read aloud.



Wanda,

The change to the specifications is the reduction of one of the pay items.

Item #25, "3" Rigid Non-Metallic Conduit" has been reduced from 2,785 linear feet to 100 linear feet. The thousands of feet of conduit, originally in the design, were already installed as part of the resurfacing project. We have kept the item just in case there are areas where additional conduit may be needed.
