RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK AND STAFF, ASSISTANT BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR AND STAFF, CITY SOLICITOR AND STAFF, CITY CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER AND STAFF, LABOR COUNSEL AND STAFF CONCERNING ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, INCLUDING THE NEGOTIATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF, WITH EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE PUBLIC BODY AND AUTHORIZING THE DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING AS PROVIDED HEREIN

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof, with employees or representative of employees of the public body; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the Mayor Members of City Council, City Clerk and Staff, Assistant Business Administrator and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, City Chief Financial Officer and Staff, Labor Counsel and Staff concerning negotiations of the Memorandum of Agreement with EMS Chief Al Lincks.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

- 1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Mayor, City Council, City Clerk and Staff, Assistant Business Administrator and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, City Chief Financial Officer and Staff, Labor Counsel and Staff on Tuesday, February 21, 2017, at 640 Wood Street, after the regular work session of City Council of the City of Vineland.
- 2. The general nature of the subject matter of the closed meeting shall pertain to a Memorandum of Agreement, including the negotiations of the terms and conditions thereof with Chief Al Lincks and/or his representative.
- 3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Mayor, Members of City Council, City Clerk and Staff, Assistant Business Administrator and Staff, City Solicitor and Staff, City Chief Financial Officer and Staff, Labor Counsel and Staff shall be made following the final decision and determination of said matter which is estimated to be 10 days.
- 4. The Clerk, at the Regular Meeting of City Council on February 14, 2017, shall read the title of said Resolution allowed so that members of the public in attendance can understand as precisely as possible the nature of the matter that will privately be discussed.
 - 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
- 6. The Clerk on the next business day following this meeting shall furnish a copy of the Resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq.
