AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 86-47 CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1986, Vineland City Council adopted Ordinance No. 86-47 concerning the appointment of special law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Governing Body of the City of Vineland to remove the residency requirement from the position of Special Law Enforcement Officer; and

WHEREAS, a residency preference system will allow for a greater pool of candidates to be considered from outside of Vineland while maintaining preference for Vineland residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that Ordinance No. 86-47 entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS PURSUANT TO THE "SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ACT", N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.8" presently known as Chapter 123, Article III of the Vineland City Code is hereby revised as follows:

Delete the following section:

Passed first reading:

§123-22. Residency requirement.

No special law enforcement officer shall be appointed to serve in the Police Department of the City of Vineland unless such person shall be a resident of the City of Vineland.

Renumber remaining sections of Article III.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect after final approval and publication as required by law.
