Resurfacing of Landis Avenue, Phase 3

(Coney Avenue to West Avenue)

SUMMARY OF PROJECT

This project will provide for the milling (2"-6" depth) and resurfacing (2"-6" depth) of hot mix asphalt. All curbing, sidewalk and driveway aprons will be replaced. This construction will also provide for the installation of new traffic markings, raised pavement reflectors and signs. Provisions for bicyclists will be met utilizing bicycle safe inlet grates. Inlet grates and castings will be removed and replaced. Drainage castings will be fitted with NJDOT approved eco-friendly curb header pieces to conform to stormwater regulations.
