A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH CONSULTING ENGINEER SERVICES, SICKLERVILLE, NJ, FOR CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR SABATER ELEMENTARY SAFE ROUTE TO SCHOOL 2014, PHASE 2 – SE & SW BOULEVARD (LANDIS AVENUE TO CHESTNUT AVENUE)

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for proposals for Professional Services for Construction Inspection Services for Sabater Elementary Safe Route to School 2014, Phase 2 – SE & SW Boulevard (Landis Avenue to Chestnut Avenue); and

WHEREAS, the Requests published on the City of Vineland's official newspapers and official website; and

WHEREAS, seven (7) proposals were received and referred to the City Engineer for evaluation and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that a contract for the required services be awarded to Consulting Engineer Services, Sicklerville, NJ based upon the proposal received, pursuant to a fair and open process; and

WHEREAS this contract is awarded in an amount not to exceed \$82,945.62 for specified services, for a contract period of 120 days from notice to proceed; and

WHEREAS, the availability of funds for said Professional Services Contract to be awarded herein have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contract for Professional Services without competitive bidding and the contract itself must be available for public inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that said contract for Professional Services for Construction Inspection Services for Sabater Elementary Safe Route to School 2014, Phase 2 – SE & SW Boulevard (Landis Avenue to Chestnut Avenue), be awarded to Consulting Engineer Services, Sicklerville, NJ, based upon the proposal received, pursuant to a fair and open process, in the amount not to exceed \$82,945.62 for a contract period of 120 days from notice to proceed.

Award Justification

CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR SABATER ELEMENTARY SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOLS 2014 – PHASE 2

Upon review of all seven (7) proposals, it was determined that Consulting Engineer Services (CES) was the most qualified firm to complete the project. Technical review rating forms are attached for review.

After ranking the proposals based on technical proficiency, the highest ranked bidder's cost proposal was opened and a meeting was scheduled to discuss the scope of work and the cost proposal.

(Take note that, in this Federal process, the only cost proposal opened is that of the highest ranked proposer from a technical standpoint.)

On May 19, 2017, David Maillet held a phone conference with representatives of CES. During that meeting, it was noted that the amount of time being devoted to Resident Engineer work appeared limited and should be moved up to truly reflect the amount of work needed in managing a Federally funded project. The consultant did admit that they cut the hours back from what they originally estimated.

On May 24, 2017, CES emailed a revised cost proposal for the work of this project.

It is the opinion of the City Engineer that Consulting Engineer Services is very well qualified to perform the work of this project and that they have worked in good faith to provide the City of Vineland with a fair and reasonable price for the services to be rendered.
