SUMMARY OF PROJECT

Specification for

To: Council Members

This specification is an open ended contract for furnishing and delivery of LED street light and flood light fixtures. The quantities of luminaires and accessories will be ordered on an as needed basis.

It also will expand the number of street lights offered. In addition, it will add LED flood lights.

The contract issued from this specification, is to replace the current LED street light contract #15-0109 (Resolution #2015-418), which ends on October 13, 2017.

We will continue to expand and refine our options for area and street lighting as they become economically feasible.

We will continue to move the City and Utility in the direction of more energy efficient lighting. In addition, this lighting will reduce the Utility's environmental "footprint" by the reduction of HID lighting fixtures we install.
