Gallagher Drive Resurfacing (Delsea Drive to Mill Road)

I respectfully request a resolution be placed on the agenda for the December 12, 2017 City Council meeting authorizing the submission of a grant and execution of a grant agreement with NJDOT for the resurfacing of Gallagher Drive, from Delsea Drive to Mill Road.

This application would meet the standards for this new funding stream out of NJDOT. The total project cost is estimated at \$400,000.
