MAY 2013 PERFORMANCE REPORT

The Vineland Municipal Electric Utility is pleased to submit its May 2013 Monthly Performance Report for your review and consideration.

#### **Employee Safety:**

The Electric Utility has a goal of zero (0) lost time accidents and less than nine (9) medical attention incidents. May year-to-date, we experienced zero (0) lost time incidents and six (6) medical attention incidents.

#### Sales and Revenue:

Sales for May year-to-date were 9.8 million kWh less than budget and 7.4 million kWh more than last year. Revenue is \$325,032 less than budget.

#### **Operating and Capital Expenditures:**

Total operating and capital expenses are \$708,730 under budget for May year-to-date.












# Delinquent Disconnections May 2012 - May 2013



# Accounts Receivable Comparison May 2012 - May 2013 Total Receivables \$5,117,845.40




VMEU Call Center Performance May 2013 Sample Week 5/28/13 - 6/03/13

#### **GLOSSARY OF TERMS**

#### **Overall Utility:**

#### **Operations and Maintenance Expenditures:**

Total Salaries and Wages plus total Actual and Encumbered Operation and Other Expenses plus Group Employee Insurance plus Social Security payments. Shown as Actual and Budgeted Expenditures.

#### Operations and Maintenance Expenditures for Distribution and Generation:

Two separate graphs showing total Salaries and Wages plus total Actual and Encumbered Operation and Other Expenses for the Distribution Division or the Generation Division. Each graph shows Actual and Budgeted Expenditures.

#### Capital Expenditures:

Total Capital Outlay including Encumbrances. Shown as Actual and Budgeted Expenditures.

#### Revenues:

Total from Light and Power Revenues plus Jobbing Revenues plus Miscellaneous Revenues plus Interest Revenues plus Revenues for Debt Service. Shown as Actual and Budgeted Revenues.

#### Safety Incidents:

The Number of Incidents that resulted in a hospital visit and/or lost time. Year-to-date Goal to Actual Comparison.

#### **Generation Division:**

#### Calendar Year Generation:

Total cumulative net generation minus auxiliary power for the Calendar Year in MWH for Unit #11 and the CT.

#### VMEU Total Net System Requirement (NSR):

Total metered VMEU customer energy requirements for a month. The total net energy flow into the VMEU service territory plus internal generation including VCLP minus station power determines system requirement.

#### **EFORD:**

The cumulative forced outage rate for all VMEU generating units, as determined by PJM and weighted for generation capacity.

#### **Supply Source:**

Total internal and external energy production and purchases for the VMEU. The supply source values do not include any sales of energy to wholesale markets or the PJM spot market.

#### **Distribution Division:**

Customer Average Interruption Duration Index (CAIDI):

Total customer-minutes interrupted/number of customers interrupted.

System Average Interruption Frequency Index (SAIFI):

Total number of customers interrupted/total number of customers.
