2013 City Road Paving Project

(Various City Roads)

SCOPE OF WORK

This project will provide for the milling (various depth) and resurfacing (various depth) of selected city roadways. Broken / settled curbing will be replaced in-kind. This construction will also provide for handicap curb cuts. Provisions for bicyclists will be met utilizing bicycle-safe inlet grates. Drainage castings will be retrofitted with NJDOT approved eco-friendly curb header pieces to conform to Stormwater regulations. Removal and replacement, in kind, of existing Stormwater drainage facilities is a part of this project.

In the event that areas of base failure are identified, those sections shall be excavated and reconstructed accordingly. The following is the list of selected streets and their associated limits as well as a summary of the work involved:
