

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-84

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND AND THE CITY OF VINELAND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SHARED SERVICES AND CONSOLIDATION ACT N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 ET SEQ. FOR SUPPORT AND SERVICES TO VINELAND'S CODE BLUE SHELTER.

WHEREAS, there is a "Code Blue" Shelter located in the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, because of the extended period of extreme cold weather in the 2017/2018 Winter Season and the associated strain placed upon the financial resources of its municipalities, "Code Blue" and its various volunteers, the County of Cumberland has offered assistance to help provide support and services for the Code Blue Shelter located in the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland and the City of Vineland are desirous of entering into a shared services agreement to provide said support and services; and

WHEREAS, the "Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act" (N.J.S.A. 40:65A-1 et seq.) provides that local units of government may enter into a contract for the joint provision of any service which either party to said agreement is empowered to render or perform within its own jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland, as follows:

1. THAT the County of Cumberland shall appropriate to the City of Vineland the amount of \$5,000.00 for the period of January 23, 2018 through December 31, 2018 towards support and services for the "Code Blue" Shelter located in the City of Vineland.
2. THAT the City of Vineland shall appropriate the amount of \$5,000.00 for the period of January 23, 2018 through December 31, 2018, towards support and services of the "Code Blue" Shelter.
3. THAT both parties agree to encourage volunteer support in an effort to meet the needs of homeless persons in Code Blue shelters within the City of Vineland.
4. THAT the parties hereto recognize and expressly state that the Code Blue Shelter is not owned, operated or maintained by the City of Vineland or the County of Cumberland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute a Shared Service Agreement by and between the Cumberland County and the City of Vineland for the support and services for the "Code Blue" Shelter located in the City of Vineland

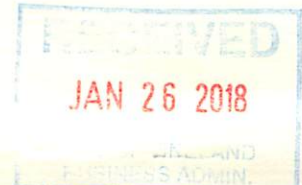

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made on this _____ day of _____ by and between the **COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND**, a body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, whose address is 164 West Broad Street, Bridgeton, NJ 08302 (hereinafter "**CUMBERLAND**") and the **CITY OF VINELAND**, a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, whose address is 640 East Wood Street, PO Box 1508, Vineland, NJ 08360 (hereinafter "**VINELAND**").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, there is a "Code Blue" shelter located in the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland has a tradition of providing financial assistance to its member municipalities and in particular, the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland is desirous of entering into a shared services agreement with the City of Vineland to provide support and services to the "Code Blue" shelter located within the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, the "Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act" (N.J.S.A. 40:65A-1 et seq.) provides that local units of government may enter into a contract for the joint provision of any service which either party to said agreement is empowered to render or perform within its own jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

1. All of the above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as if repeated at length..
2. **CUMBERLAND** shall appropriate the amount of **FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS** to the City of Vineland for the period January 23, 2018 through December 31, 2018, towards support and services for the "Code Blue" Shelter.
3. **VINELAND** shall also appropriate the amount of **FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS** for the period January 23, 2018 through December 31, 2018, towards support and services for the "Code Blue" Shelter.
4. Both parties agree to provide additional logistic support in an effort to meet the needs of homeless persons in Code Blue shelters in general and, in particular, in the City of Vineland such as security, transportation or assistance in the transport of materials or supplies.
5. The parties hereto recognize and expressly state that the Code Blue Shelter is not

owned, operated or maintained by **CUMBERLAND**.

6. It is further recognized and agreed by the parties that employees of the Code Blue Shelter are not agents, servants or employees of **CUMBERLAND**.


7. The term of this Agreement shall be from January 23, 2018 through December 31, 2018.



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH THE CITY OF VINELAND TO PROVIDE SUPPORT AND
SERVICES FOR CODE BLUE**

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland has a long standing tradition of offering assistance to its member municipalities; and

WHEREAS, because of the extended period of extreme cold weather in the 2017/2018 Winter Season and the associated strain placed upon the financial resources of its municipalities, "Code Blue" and its various volunteers, the County of Cumberland has offered assistance for the City of Vineland "Code Blue" Shelter; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland is desirous of entering into a shared services agreement with the City of Vineland to provide support and services to the Code Blue Shelter; and

WHEREAS, under said agreement, the County will contribute Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars and the City of Vineland will contribute Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars for a total of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars towards support and services for the "Code Blue" Shelter; and

WHEREAS, each party agrees to provide additional logistical support in an effort to meet the needs of homeless persons in Code Blue shelters in general and, in particular, in the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.) provides that local units of government may enter into a contract for the joint provision of

any service which either party to said agreement is empowered to render or perform within its own jurisdiction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, as follows:

1. That the shared services agreement between the City of Vineland and Cumberland County for support and services for the "Code Blue" Shelter in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the period from January 23, 2018 to December 31, 2018, is hereby approved in the form on file with the Clerk of this Board.

2. That said agreement shall be charged to Line Item Appropriation or Account No. 8-01-27-789-205-749.
