ORDINANCE NO. 2018-<u>36</u>

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,000,000 FROM THE ELECTRIC UTILITY'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES AND CONTROL ROOM FOR THE ELECTRIC UTILITY IN AND BY THE CITY OF VINELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$4,000,000 is hereby appropriated from the Electric Utility's Capital Improvement Fund for the construction of administrative offices and control room for the Electric Utility, including the reconstruction and renovation at 57 Park Avenue, design fees, the installation of security systems, fire alarms, card access, supervisory control and data acquisition, voice and data systems, fiber optics, the acquisition of furniture, appliances and television and computer screens and the acquisition and installation of an emergency generator in the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, New Jersey (the "City"), including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Section 2. The City hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the City is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.

Dear Susan:

In accordance with your request, I have prepared and enclose herewith a form of ordinance appropriating moneys from the Electric Utility's Capital Improvement Fund. The ordinance should be adopted in accordance with the procedure set forth below for your convenience.

In order to comply with the capital budget regulations, the ordinance contains a provision amending the capital budget to the extent of any inconsistency with the ordinance and it should be sent to Trenton and filed along with the resolution of the governing body in the form required by the Local Finance Board showing the details of the amended capital budget. It will not be necessary to publish the resolution.

The ordinance may be introduced and read by title only and adopted by a majority of the members of the governing body present, assuming a quorum. After introduction, the Notice of Pending Ordinance and Summary must be published in the local newspaper, a form of which I have enclosed for your use. Also, the ordinance should be posted on the bulletin board customarily used for notices, together with the Notice of Pending Ordinance and Summary, and copies of the ordinance should be made available to anyone who requests them of the Clerk after introduction.

The ordinance can be considered for final adoption not less than ten days after introduction and not less than seven days after the first publication of the ordinance together with the Notice of Pending Ordinance and Summary. If the ordinance has been posted and copies made available as indicated above, the ordinance can be read at the second hearing by title only. If the ordinance posting procedure has not been followed, the ordinance must be read in full at the second hearing. After the ordinance is read for the second time, the governing body should hold a public hearing and should give all members of the public a chance to be heard on the ordinance and to ask pertinent questions. After the public hearing, the ordinance can be finally adopted as required by applicable law. After final adoption, the Ordinance Statement and Summary must be published, a copy of which I have enclosed for your use. Note that if the approval of an officer is required to make the ordinance effective, the ordinance must be approved by that officer, or passed over veto, before it is published after final adoption.

After the ordinance is finally adopted, it will be necessary for us to establish a record of proceedings documenting its proper adoption. In order to do this, we will need one completely executed set of the documents enumerated on the attached checklist. By copy of this letter, I am sending the Clerk a copy of the checklist along with a copy of the ordinance. With the exception of the Affidavits of Publication, I am also sending the Clerk the necessary certificates to be completed, executed and returned to us along with the necessary attachments to provide us with this documentation.
