RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF TWO (2) GMC BLUEBIRD BUSES FROM THE VINELAND BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR USE BY THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND THE POLICE ATHLETIC LEAGUE (PAL)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to accept title to two GMC Bluebird buses from the Vineland Board of Education at no cost to be used by the EMS and PAL.
