WHEREAS, the Business Administrator has, under date of February 5, 2019 submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that a contract for the furnishing of 2019 Landfill MW & Methane Testing, be awarded to Eurofins QC, LLC, Horsham, PA, in the amount of \$21,724.00, said bid being the lowest bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that said contract for the furnishing of 2019 Landfill MW & Methane Testing, be and the same is awarded to Eurofins QC, LLC, Horsham, PA, on their bid in the amount of \$21,724.00, said bid being the lowest bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland, and the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue purchase order contract for the same in behalf of the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Comptroller has certified that the funds for the contract to be awarded herein are available.
