A RESOLUTION AWARDED A CONTRACT TO WINNER FORD, CHERRY HILL, NJ FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SIX (6) 2018 OR NEWER AWD SUV POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLES & INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEMS & RELATED EQUIPMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$334,463.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for bids for the Supply and Delivery of Six (6) 2018 or Newer AWD SUV Police Pursuit Vehicles & Installation of Emergency Warning Systems & Related Equipment, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2019, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Business Administrator for tabulation, evaluation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator has, under date of March 5, 2019 submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that a contract for the Supply and Delivery of Six (6) 2018 or Newer AWD SUV Police Pursuit Vehicles & Installation of Emergency Warning Systems & Related Equipment, be awarded to Winner Ford, Cherry Hill, NJ, in the amount of \$334,463.00, said bid being the lowest responsive responsible bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that said contract for the Supply and Delivery of Six (6) 2018 or Newer AWD SUV Police Pursuit Vehicles & Installation of Emergency Warning Systems & Related Equipment, be and the same is awarded to Winner Ford, Cherry Hill, NJ, in the amount of \$334,463.00, said bid being the lowest responsive responsible bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland, and the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue purchase order contract for the same in behalf of the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Comptroller has certified that the funds for the contract to be awarded herein are available.

Submitted to you herewith for your consideration is our evaluation of the proposals submitted to the Purchasing Board on February 12, 2019.


SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SIX (6) 2018 OR NEWER AWD SUV POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLES & INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEMS & RELATED EQUIPMENT

It is the recommendation of the Chief of Police which has the concurrence of the Purchasing Agent and the Business Administrator that a contract be awarded to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, Winner Ford, Cherry Hill, NJ, in the amount of \$334,463.00.

The Police Department indicated that in an effort to purchase as many vehicles as possible, while still reducing costs, one of vehicles will be assigned as a Patrol Supervisor vehicle. This vehicle will not need a prisoner partition, radar unit, or mobile printer installed. The reduction of this equipment accounts for the difference in what was bid versus what will be awarded.


