WHEREAS, the Cumberland Cape Atlantic YMCA anticipates the continued grant funding from the New Jersey Healthy Communities Network (Family Health Initiatives) to support the work of the Worksite Wellness Initiative a component of the Live Healthy Vineland project; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland Cape Atlantic YMCA has agreed to award to the City of Vineland Department of Health, a total of \$6,000.00 for the grant period February 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 to provide ongoing technical assistance and support to worksites who are part of the Live Healthy Vineland worksite wellness program; and

The City of Vineland Health Department agrees to:

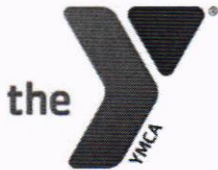
1. Provide ongoing technical assistance and support to worksites who are part of the Live Healthy Vineland worksite wellness program.


