

ORDINANCE NO. 2020- 39

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$105,310.00 FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF WATER EQUIPMENT FOR WATER SERVICE RENEWAL AND WATER RADIO MODULE UPGRADES.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland is undergoing a City Wide Road Paving Project which will cause the existing roadways to be paved; and

WHEREAS, the City water infrastructure is reaching or has reached its life expectancy and is in need of upgrades; and

WHEREAS, it is economically feasible to perform the underground upgrades to the water system prior to undertaking the paving project; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Municipal Utilities has recommended the City Water Utility perform water service renewal and install water radio modules so water meters may be electronically read to save in costs of operation of the utility and funding for the water service renewal and water radio modules upgrades should be appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$105,310.00 from the Water Utility’s Capital Improvement Fund Balance for the purchase of water equipment and services for water services renewal and water radio module upgrades, including the cost of project engineering, research, approvals and permits, and other applications as needed, including all work and materials necessary therefore and incidental thereto.

Section 2. The City of Vineland hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the City is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been or will be filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication or as otherwise provided by law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any portion of this Ordinance be deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that portion so determined to be unenforceable, shall be void and the balance hereof shall remain in full force and effect.
