

ORDINANCE NO. 2020- 48

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG REILLY COURT.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited along the entire limits of Reilly Court; and

WHEREAS, said recommendation has the concurrence of the Vineland Police Department and the City Solicitor and is considered to be in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND THAT:

SECTION 1. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Reilly Court	Both	Entire Length

SECTION 2. Signs shall be erected and maintained as authorized by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
