- 2. That, additionally, Maser Consulting shall be declared the winning bidder for the Cumberland County Cooperative Contract Purchasing System Identifier #181-CCCCPS.
- 3. That the proper officers of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract hereby awarded.
- 4. That proper account numbers will be identified and funds encumbered prior to services being provided.
