

RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 73

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR FY2020 HAZARDOUS MATERIALS EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (HMEP) PLANNING AND TRAINING.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation provides grant funding for the Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) Grant Program administered by the State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety Office of the Attorney General, has submitted to the City of Vineland Department of Fire notice of grant subaward #2020-14, for the FY2020 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds in the amount \$3,900.00 will provide training for employees to respond to accidents and incidents involving hazardous materials and/or develop emergency hazardous incident plans, for the subaward period of September 30, 2020 through September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be in the best interest of the City of Vineland that said funding be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

1. THAT the City of Vineland does hereby accept the subaward grant #2020-14, for the FY2020 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) Program for the Vineland Department of Fire, in the amount of \$3,900.00 for the subaward period of September 30, 2020 through September 30, 2021.
2. THAT the Mayor of the City of Vineland be and the same is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and such other related documents as required.
3. THAT the City of Vineland agrees to undertake its obligations under the grant agreement.
