

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 40

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 86-47, AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 123, ARTICLE III OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS .

WHEREAS, within the Vineland Police Department is a position of Special Law Enforcement Officer who serves as a liaison officer assigned to the Vineland Municipal Court and assists in discussing with defendants potential plea agreements for such offenses that are permitted to be negotiated with the express approval of the municipal; prosecutor in accordance with the Rules of Court; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2016-23 sets forth the salary and compensation of the Court Liaison Officer to be equal to that of Class II officers; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 123, Section 123-24 of the Code of the City of Vineland establishes a salary for the Court Liaison Officer which is in conflict with the method of calculation for the rate of pay for the Court Liaison Officer and needs to be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that Ordinance 86-47, Chapter 123, Article III, Section 123-24 D be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Section 123-24 D

Part Time Court Liaison Officers assigned to the Vineland Municipal Court shall be paid an hourly wage equal to Class II Officers in accordance with Section 123 B and C herein above.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any portion of Ordinance 86-47, as amended, not amended hereby shall remain in full force and affect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any portion of this Ordinance be deemed unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the balance hereof shall remain in full force and affect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any ordinance or portion thereof that is in conflict with this Ordinance shall be vacated to the extent of the conflict.
