A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING
WYNONNA JUDD UPON HER LANDIS THEATER
PERFORMANCE ON JULY 15, 2021.

WHEREAS, Wynonna Judd, a multi award-winning American country music singer is performing at Vineland's Landis Theater on Thursday, July 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Wynonna Judd is one of America's most widely recognized and awarded female country singers, first rising to fame in the 1980s alongside her mother Naomi in the country music duo the Judds, and she has also distinguished herself as an author, philanthropist and actress; and

WHEREAS, Wynonna Judd released seven albums on Curb Records in addition to 26 singles, of which 14 were number-one hits and she was presented with a star on the Music City Walk of Fame in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Wynonna Judd received the USO's Merit Award in 2005 for service to all divisions of the United States Armed Forces and teamed up with Habitat for Humanity to record "Heart of America," with Michael McDonald and Eric Benet, which helped raise over \$90 million for victims of natural disasters to the Gulf Coast, and she continues to bring awareness to the global emergency of AIDS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Governing Body of the City of Vineland join to recognize and commend Wynonna Judd for her performance at Vineland's Landis Theater, as the first major headliner to help end the pandemic. We also join in acknowledging her musical talents as well as her impressive philanthropic endeavors.
