Re: Letter of Agreement with the Cumberland Cape Atlantic YMCA and the Vineland Health Department for the FY 2021 Community Hubs Grant

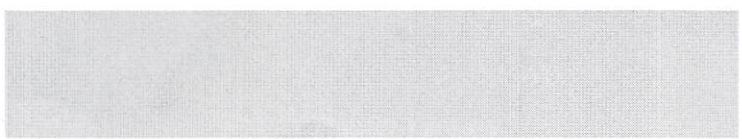


Re: Letter of Agreement




