A RESOLUTION AWARDING AN OPEN-ENDED CONTRACT TO MPW INDUSTRIAL WATER SERVICES, INC., HEBRON, OH FOR THE FURNISHING, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF MOBILE DEMINERALIZER SYSTEMS FOR UNIT 11 & CLAYVILLE UNIT 1, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$157,370.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for bids for the furnishing, delivery and installation of Mobile Demineralizer Systems for Unit 11 & Clayville Unit 1, for a period of one year starting November 1, 2021 ending October 31, 2022, with option to renew for one additional year, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Business Administrator for tabulation, evaluation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator has, under date of August 2, 2021 submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that an open-ended contract for the furnishing, delivery and installation of Mobile Demineralizer Systems for Unit 11 & Clayville Unit 1, be awarded to MPW Industrial Water Services, Inc., Hebron, OH, based on unit pricing, with the estimated contract total amount not to exceed \$157,370.00, said bid being the only bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that said open-ended contract for the furnishing, delivery and installation of Mobile Demineralizer Systems for Unit 11 & Clayville Unit 1, for a period of one year starting November 1, 2021 ending October 31, 2022, with option to renew for one additional year, be and the same is awarded to MPW Industrial Water Services, Inc., Hebron, OH, based on unit pricing, with the estimated contract total amount not to exceed \$157,370.00, said bid being the only bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland, and the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue purchase order contract for the same in behalf of the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the funds for the contract to be awarded herein are available.
