A RESOLUTION AWARDED AN OPEN-END CONTRACT
TO CTX INFRASTRUCTURE, HAMMONTON, NJ FOR
DIRECTIONAL DRILLING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for bids for Directional Drilling Services for the Vineland Municipal Electric Utility, for a period of one year from date of award with option for a second year renewal, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2022, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Business Administrator for tabulation, evaluation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator has, under date of April 12, 2022 submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that an open-end contract for Directional Drilling Services for the Vineland Municipal Electric Utility, be awarded to CTX Infrastructure, Hammonton, NJ, in the amount not to exceed \$190,000.00, said bid being the lowest responsive responsible bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that said contract for Directional Drilling Services for the Vineland Municipal Electric Utility, for a period of one year from date of award with option for a second year renewal, be and the same is awarded to CTX Infrastructure, Hammonton, NJ, in the amount not to exceed \$190,000.00, said bid being the lowest responsive responsible bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland, and the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue purchase order contract for the same in behalf of the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the funds for the contract to be awarded herein are available.


Submitted to you herewith for your consideration is our evaluation of the proposals submitted to the Purchasing Board on March 22, 2022.



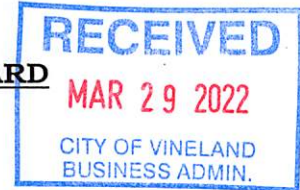
