

RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 221

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH TERRA TECH SERVICES, LLC, DOWNINGTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE DECOMMISSIONING AND DEMOLITION OF HOWARD M. DOWN GENERATING STATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,700,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has hereto fore advertised for bids to be received for the decommissioning and demolition of the Howard M. Down Generating station which is no longer in use, in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the Purchasing Agent of the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2022, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Business Administrator, Municipal Electric Utility staff and Purchasing Agent for review and tabulation; and

WHEREAS, after opening said bids, tabulating the same, the apparent lowest bidder was determined to be Terra Tech Services, Downingtown, Pennsylvania whose submissions were referred to the firm of Golder Associates, USA, Inc., Lansing Michigan (Golder) for review, evaluation and report to determine if the apparent lowest bidder would be considered having been responsive to the bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, after review by the Electric Utility staff, Purchasing Agent and Golder, it was determined that the apparent lowest responsive responsible bidder for the decommissioning and demolition of the Howard M. Down Generating Station is Terra Tech Services LLC and Golder, the Purchasing Agent and Electric Utility staff recommended the contract be awarded to Terra Tech Services, LLC in the bid amount of \$6,700.000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer of the City has certified the availability of funds from account no. 2-05-55-512-9001-52000 tracking id E306P-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that a contract for the decommissioning and demolition of the Howard M. Down Generating Station be awarded to Terra Tech Services, LLC in accordance with their bid received on March 22, 2022, said bid being the lowest responsive bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland and the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and directed to issue a contract for the same incorporating therein the bid specifications and bid submitted thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution and contract be sent to the Office of the State Comptroller, as required.


