A RESOLUTION AWARDING AN OPEN-END CONTRACT TO GEORGE S. COYNE CHEMICAL CO., INC., CROYDON, PA, FOR THE FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF CHLORINE GAS & TABLETS FOR WATER TREATMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$78,379.92.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for bids for the furnishing and delivery of Chlorine Gas & Tablets for Water Treatment, for a period of one year from date of award, with an option for a second year, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2022, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Business Administrator for tabulation, evaluation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator has, under date of September 6, 2022, submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that an open-end contract for the furnishing and delivery of Chlorine Gas & Tablets for Water Treatment, be awarded to George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc., Croydon, PA, in the amount of \$78,379.92, said bid being the lowest responsive responsible bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that said open-end contract for the furnishing and delivery of Chlorine Gas & Tablets for Water Treatment, for a period of one year from date of award, with an option for a second year , be and the same is awarded to George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc., Croydon, PA, on their bid in the amount of \$78,379.92, said bid being the lowest responsive responsible bid received and considered in the best interest of the City of Vineland, and the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to issue purchase order contract for the same in behalf of the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Comptroller has certified that the funds for the contract to be awarded herein are available.
