The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Paul F. Spinelli.

The Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on December 13, 2017 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

Steve Lewis commented that it was good to see a reporter from *The Daily Journal* (Joe Smith) in attendance tonight.

The Clerk reviewed the changes to the agenda since the May 15 work session. Resolution No. 2018-214, to amend and supplement Resolution No. 2017-124 authorizing a contract for public relations/marketing services, in the amount of \$4,260.94, was added. Resolution No. 2018-215, authorizing special law enforcement officers for the year 2018, was added. Resolution No. 2018-216, authorizing the issuance of original and renewal taxicab licenses for the year 2018, was added. Resolution No. 2018-217, authorizing the director of the department of Licenses & Inspections to issue various original and/or renewal licenses for the year 2018, was added. Resolution No. 2018-218, granting the renewal of alcoholic beverage licenses for the licensing period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019, was added.

The Clerk reminded members that there is no scheduled meeting next week. The first work session in June is on Monday, June 4, because of the primary election on Tuesday. Also, there will not be a meeting the week of the Independence Day holiday, the first work session that month will be on July 10.

Councilwoman Calakos reported that the Beatles tribute band last Saturday at the Landis Theater was enjoyed by all who attended. She encouraged attendance at the Genesis tribute band concert in June.

Councilman Franceschini stated that he attended the VHS food truck festival last Saturday. He reminded everyone that the Health Department will present the winners of the food safety calendar artwork tonight. He also reported that the Health Department is working with swimming pool operators to comply with the new regulations.
