Resolution No. 2018-308, granting the renewal of alcoholic beverage licenses for the licensing period July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2019, was added. Resolution No. 2018-309, authorizing the person-to-person and place-to-place transfer of alcoholic beverage plenary retail consumption license No. 0614-33-017-011 from RGR Spirits LLC to Olive Garden Holdings LLC, d/b/a The Olive Garden Italian Restaurant #6419, for premises located at 3880 South Delsea Drive, effective August 3, 2018.

Councilwoman Calakos announced that the show "Legally Blond" will be performed at the Landis Theater next weekend.

President Spinelli reviewed the Puerto Rican Festival parade. He also reminded others about the food truck festival in August and National Night Out celebration at the VHS complex on August 7.
