The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Paul F. Spinelli.

President Spinelli led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk reviewed changes to the agenda since the July 16 work session. Resolution No. 2019-316 was revised, adding Company 1 to approving membership of Robert Walker, Jr. as a volunteer firefighter. Resolution No. 2019-317, authorizing the execution of a subordination of mortgage liens held by the City of Vineland with respect to property known as 8 Elmwood Avenue, was added. Solicitor Tonetta provided a brief description of this action. Resolution No. 2019-318, authorizing a closed session concerning personnel and appointment to the position of deputy municipal clerk, was added.

Councilman Franceschini distributed a letter from Cumberland County Freeholder Carol Musso as a follow-up to their meeting about the CATs transportation service. He noted that Health Department Director Carre disagrees with many of the points made. Councilman Franceschini plans to look into the matter further.

Councilman Vargas reported that there was a special Recreation Commission last night. There are issues with the VBA league, as parents are interfering on the courts. There was a suggestion to use Class I specials to assist in keeping order.

President Spinelli noted the upcoming VDID Food Truck Festival with approximately 20 or more trucks participating this year. The mural by George Perez is progressing and expected to be completed in October. The track dedication honoring Ernie Marcacci at Romano Park has been moved to this Thursday at 4 p.m.
