## When doing home improvements, remember these guidelines when placing trash at the curb for collection:

- Only bagged household trash is allowed at the curb in your city issued cart.
- No construction or renovation material is permitted at the curb. Your contractor can usually remove it for you, but if they don't, then you are responsible for its removal.
- Consider recycling whenever possible for materials such as wood, asphalt shingles, brick, and concrete. Try some nearby companies like

Winzinger's in Franklinville (856-694-1887),

South State in Bridgeton (856-451-5300),

South Jersey Agricultural Products in Elmer (856-358-0990), or call 856-794-4089 for additional recycling centers in the South Jersey area.

- Call 856-794-4089 to schedule an appliance/white good pick up.
- Remember that asbestos is a hazardous waste and must be prepared and disposed of accordingly.
- Rugs and padding can be placed at the curb side BUT MUST BE rolled and tied securely with a rope, cord, or duct tape. No more than 4 bundles, not longer that 4' in length will be accepted at the curb. More than 4 bundles will be considered construction/demolition debris and will be declined.
